This Breeding Services Contract ("Agreement") is made and entered into this **day of** , **2026, by and between Victory Farms Andalusians, LLC ("VFA" or "Stallion Owner"), a Colorado limited liability company, and** ("Mare Owner"), whose address and contact information are as follows:

1. Stallion and Mare

Mare Owner agrees to breed the following mare:

The mare shall be bred to the stallion **Camelio ANG II**.

Mare Owner certifies that the mare is accurately represented above and is suitable for breeding.

1A. Mare Health and Veterinary Requirements

Mare Owner warrants that the mare is in good health and reproductively sound at the time of breeding.

Mare Owner agrees that the mare shall be examined and cleared for breeding by a licensed veterinarian prior to insemination.

Upon request, Mare Owner shall provide written veterinary confirmation of reproductive soundness.

Failure of the mare to conceive due to uterine infection, improper timing, age-related infertility, poor reproductive management, or any other mare-related condition shall not constitute a breach of this Agreement by Victory Farms Andalusians.

2. Stud Fee and Payment Terms

The stud fee for this breeding is \$__.

A booking fee of \$500 is due at the time of signing this Agreement and will be applied toward the stud fee.

The remaining balance of the stud fee may be paid according to a mutually agreed payment plan; however, the stud fee must be paid **in full upon veterinary confirmation of pregnancy with a detectable heartbeat (approximately 40 days)**, unless otherwise agreed to in writing.

the booking fee shall be refundable solely in the event that viable semen cannot be successfully collected and shipped, as determined in writing by the attending reproductive veterinarian.

In the event that a mare does not conceive, the booking fee shall be non-refundable unless the attending reproductive veterinarian determines in writing that the failure to conceive was directly attributable to documented stallion semen quality concerns, including clinically significant low motility, as determined in writing by the attending reproductive veterinarian.

In all other circumstances, including but not limited to mare condition, timing, management, or shipping delays, the booking fee shall be non-refundable.

If the mare does not conceive, Mare Owner shall be responsible for all collection, semen preparation, veterinary, and shipping fees incurred.

3. Veterinary Services, Collection, and Shipping

Victory Farms Andalusians utilizes a professional reproductive veterinary clinic for semen collection and preparation.

All veterinary services, including but not limited to:

- semen collection
- semen preparation
- shipping and courier services
- mare care
- insemination
- ultrasounds, cultures, hormone therapy, and reproductive management

shall be **arranged and paid directly by the Mare Owner** to the attending veterinary clinic and are **separate from the stud fee owed to VFA**.

If Mare Owner elects to use VFA's local veterinary clinic for mare care and insemination, all arrangements and payments shall be made directly between Mare Owner and the clinic.

4. Shipped Semen Disclaimer

Mare Owner further understands and agrees that conception is not guaranteed with shipped semen.

All risks associated with the use of shipped semen are assumed solely by the Mare Owner.

Mare Owner understands and agrees that conception is not guaranteed with shipped semen.

Once semen leaves the collection facility, **Victory Farms Andalusians assumes no responsibility for delays, mishandling, temperature fluctuations, courier error, acts of God, or failure to conceive due to timing, mare condition, or insemination technique.**

All risks associated with the use of shipped semen are assumed solely by the Mare Owner.

5. Collection Discretion and Stallion Welfare

The frequency, timing, and approval of stallion collections shall be determined solely by Victory Farms Andalusians and its attending veterinarian, in the best interest of the stallion.

VFA reserves the right to refuse, delay, or limit collections at its sole discretion.

5A. Multiple Mare Bookings

When a Mare Owner books more than one mare, each mare shall be considered a separate breeding and shall be subject to its own contract, booking fee, and breeding terms.

6. Live Foal Guarantee

Victory Farms Andalusians provides a **live foal guarantee**, defined as a foal that stands, nurses, and lives for at least twenty-four (24) hours.

If a mare, after being certified in foal by a qualified veterinarian, aborts, fails to produce a live foal, or if the mare or foal dies, Mare Owner shall be entitled to a **return breeding** for the same mare or another mare approved by VFA, provided:

- VFA is notified in writing within seventy-two (72) hours of the loss, and
- a written statement from a licensed veterinarian detailing the circumstances is provided within ten (10) days.

This return breeding must be used within twelve (12) months and does not include veterinary, collection, or shipping fees.

7. Stallion Service Certificate and Registration

Stallion service certificates will be issued only after:

- the birth of a live foal has been reported in writing, and
- the stud fee has been paid in full.

Registration of the foal is the sole financial responsibility of the Mare Owner. VFA agrees to reasonably assist with required documentation.

8. Assignment and Termination

This Agreement may not be assigned or transferred without the prior written consent of Victory Farms Andalusians.

Victory Farms Andalusians reserves the right to terminate this Agreement **for cause**, including but not limited to non-payment, misrepresentation, breach of contract, unsafe mare handling, or veterinary concerns.

If the stallion dies, is sold, or becomes permanently unfit for service prior to breeding, or if the mare dies prior to service, the booking fee shall be refunded and this Agreement shall be terminated.

9. Governing Law and Venue

This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Colorado.

Any legal action arising from this Agreement shall be brought exclusively in **El Paso County, Colorado**.

10. Cancellation and Emergency Considerations

Victory Farms Andalusians understands that unforeseen circumstances may arise. In the event of a documented family emergency or illness on the day of a scheduled breeding or collection, the Mare Owner shall not forfeit their booking fee. Rescheduling will be coordinated in good faith between both parties and the attending veterinarian.

11. Entire Agreement

This Agreement constitutes the entire understanding between the parties and supersedes all prior discussions or representations. Any amendments must be in writing and signed by both parties.
