Electricity and water are available. If you need electricity, please bring an extension cord. Cell service at the farm can be spotty, so please have a backup plan for payment systems or anything requiring cellular service. Wi-Fi is available for vendors. Vendors participating both days may leave their booths set up overnight.

## **A Festival With a Purpose**

The Victory Farms Fall Festival is a fundraiser benefiting **Mary's Home**. Victory Farms will be donating festival proceeds to support their work. Vendors are welcome - but certainly not obligated - to join us in giving in whatever way feels appropriate, whether through a set amount, a percentage of sales, or another contribution.

Mary's Home is a faith-based supportive housing program serving single mothers and children who are working toward permanently exiting homelessness. Mothers in the program receive support and learning opportunities designed to build holistic health, life skills, and economic self-sufficiency while their children attend childcare or school.

Mothers, children, and the director of Mary's Home are **invited to join us** at the festival on Saturday.
